Magis Awards

In recognition of:

- Sustained, positive attitude to learning in class
- Consistent application and effort in all classes
- Regular attendance in classes
- Demonstrated commitment to improving classroom performance.

Christian Leadership Awards

In recognition of:

- Positive and supportive interaction with peers
- Demonstrated empathy with students
- Initiative in assisting staff and students
- Demonstrated leadership at class/level/whole school community events.

Community Award

- One award per year level/house.
- Students who have continually contributed to, and supported the College through involvement in class activities, school activities and extra-curricular activities.

Junior Performing Arts Award

The Junior Performing Arts award is presented to a student who has displayed exceptional talent in the area of the Performing Arts.

The selected student will have been involved in either Music, Drama or Dance or a combination of all the Performing Arts.

St Francis Xavier Award for College Captains

For dedicated service to the College as College Captains for 2023.

ADF Long Tan Leadership and Teamwork Award

Leadership, teamwork, values, problem-solving, resourcefulness, communication, cooperation and community involvement.

ADF Future Innovators Award

The awards are a means to formally recognise those students who have demonstrated motivation and innovation in the areas of STEM within their school, and who display strong personal ethical values, such as doing one's best.

Sportsperson of the Year Award

- Students must have competed in a number of GISSA teams in the year.
- Students must demonstrate a high level of sporting achievement and contribution to their teams.
- Students must display good sportsmanship, contribution, and attitude towards coaches, teachers, the College and the wider community.
- The nomination of candidates and the selection of candidates to receive the awards can also be based upon the following criteria:



- The quality and commitment of the student in the activity over a sustained period. The significance of the sport in the life of the College.
- The level of achievement the student has reached in sports/activities outside the College.
- The student's coaching and managing responsibilities of junior teams.
- The time commitment to the sport/activity.
- Areas of responsibility in that sport/activity.
- Promptness to meetings/trainings/matches.

Sam McIntosh Award

- Student has participated in GISSA throughout their academic journey at the College, displaying good sportsmanship, contribution, and attitude towards coaches.
- Student has reached high achievement in sport at a state, national or international level.
- Student has displayed leadership through team coaching, management or mentoring others.
- Students has demonstrated commitment to sport beyond graduation at a state, national or international level.
- Student has a commitment to continuing the relationship with the College in connecting with the school and their chosen sport beyond graduation.

The Deakin Young Influencer Award

The Deakin Young Influencer Award is for a current Year 11 student who:

- Has made an outstanding contribution to their school or local community, or perhaps a community in need in Australia or overseas.
- Demonstrates a real willingness to help, coach, teach or care for others in a significant way.
- Fosters inclusive and supportive environments wherever they go.
- Shows a willingness to challenge preconceived ideas and the status quo.
- Is a strong leader, helping to bring about change for the betterment of others.
- Generates and applies new ideas and fresh thinking to real-world problems and help to deliver new solutions that make positive impacts.
- Shares knowledge and cultivates connections on a local level, or, far and wide.
- Are committed students who have achieved above-average Year 11 results.

St Ignatius of Loyola Award

Senior Performing Arts Award

A VCE student who:

- Demonstrates an ongoing commitment to their studies in Dance, Drama and Music or a combination of these subjects. Maintains excellence in one or more of the VCE subjects.

Demonstrates a willingness to contribute to the promotion of the Performing Arts in the wider school community through participation in extra-curricular events such as musical evenings and College Productions.

The Gonzaga Prize

A graduating student showing high levels of leadership, compassion and courage.

Ampol All-rounder

Acknowledges a final year student who has made an exceptional contribution both in and out of the classroom.

The award recognises qualities that include: Leadership, Service and community, Sport, Arts and culture, Attitude, and Personal conduct.

Corangamite Leadership and Community Spirit Award (Libby Coker)

A graduating student who has shown high levels of leadership, teamwork and determination.

Alison Marchant Bellarine Community Leadership Award

Awarded to the student who best exemplifies the principles of community leadership and demonstrates your schools' values.

Academic Excellence in Unit 3&4 Coursework Awards

This award is presented to the highest achieving student in each VCE Unit 3/4 subject, based upon results attained in School Assessed Coursework or School Assessed Course Tasks and other relevant criteria.

VCE Leadership Award

This award is given to individuals that display leadership qualities and a commitment to making a positive contribution at the College and in the Community.





Jesuit Alumni Award

Founded in 1854 and located adjacent to the Cathedral, St Patrick's College East Melbourne was the first Catholic secondary school and pioneer seminary for priestly formation in Melbourne. In 1865 it was entrusted to the care of the newly arrived Irish Jesuits. As their earliest work and oldest school in Australia, it was the source of over 250 priests and many civic and sporting leaders over a 114-year period.

Although closed nearly fifty years ago, its alumni association (SPOCA) continues to provide ongoing support for the works of the Australian Jesuit Province, to foster fellowship contacts between many of its 400 members and to be the custodian of the history and spirit of the College. Tonight this award, sponsored by the St Patrick's SJ Old Collegians Association, will be given to the graduate of Saint Ignatius College who is deemed to be most living up to the school motto and the Jesuit ethos, 'To Love and to Serve.'

The award is being presented tonight by the President of the St Patrick's College Alumni Association.

House Medallion Awards

The House Medal is intended to recognise and honour students who consistently display exceptional characteristics that are linked to each House's patron Saint, exemplifying the core values and principles we uphold at Saint Ignatius College, Geelong. This award aims to motivate and encourage students to cultivate positive traits and foster a sense of pride, camaraderie, and healthy competition within our school community and to continue to build our House community and identity.

House Shield

Saint Ignatius College Geelong introduced a new, and more inclusive House structure in the 2023 academic year. The new House structure provided a deepened sense of identity and belonging, and gave students further opportunities for greater participation in more areas of College life. Tonight, the new House Shield will be awarded to the first student House Leaders of this inaugural Shield.

Being a lifelong learner, and continually striving for the Magis in all that they do.

Their embodiment of Amare et Servire, 'to love and to serve' all members of the College Community.

Embracing all elements of the College crest in encouraging others to 'reach for the stars' and 'to let their light shine brightly.'

Their belief in the Servant Leadership Model, which is fundamental to an Ignatian School, in valuing and demonstrating leadership through service and advocating for others, particularly those in need.

There are 2 recipients of this annual award, a teaching member and an Education Support Officer.
